

## In Red and White

The tasting, an overview of wines from the South of France, became a fitting homage to the astonishing work of the late Laurent Vaillé of Grange des Pères, with these old vintages (in white and red) receiving deserved acclaim.

While at La Pèira we keep a library selection of old vintages, production is so small that they number around a hundred bottles. Two vintages we do have a little more of (as they were not so acclaimed on initial release) are the La Pèira 2008 and the La Pèira Blanc 2014. Both serve as excellent indications of the cuvée's capacity to age, and we were delighted to include them in the selection.

The overview considered pioneers of the region such as Daumas Gassac, Mas Jullien, and Grange des Pères, as well as the broader progression of fine wines in the South. Most notably, an appreciation of the astonishing — and near-perfect — Grange des Pères Blanc 2014 served as a fitting tribute to the incredible work of the late Laurent Vaillé.
